Can you make a Plant Life Cycle?







Outdoor Learning

Stick tallies:

Choose a number to represent. Instead of drawing tally marks on paper, use sticks to show a number. Once your number



is created, practice counting by fives to your total.

Target Toss Addition: Using sidewalk chalk or a stick in the dirt, create a large target. Decide what the value of each ring will be. Each player will take turns throwing the rocks and adding up their total based



on where the rocks have landed.

Make Explore Create

Texture Exploration:

Find items around the house that can be used to make impressions in playdoh. You can use plastic beads, a comb, lego, blocks, cutlery, coins and many other



household items. Press the items into the play-doh to see what you can create for textures or patterns.

Easy No Cook Playdough

Ingredients:

- 2 c. flour
- 1 c. salt
- 3 tablespoons cream of tartar (powder)
- 2 tablespoons oil
- · 2 c. boiling water
- 1 tsp. Peppermint extract (optional)
- Food coloring (optional)



No cooking required! Put all ingredients in a bowl and stir! Knead until smooth. Easy right?!? (Note: You cannot mess this one up!)
