- 1) Teams will be given a 10 minute on court warm-up if tournament is running behind. The warm-up will consist of a 5-5 attacking warm-up. The 10 minutes will start once the court is clear. All attacking warm-ups will use the 5-5 format and teams must serve (if they wish) within the
- 2) Volleyball Canada tie-breaking procedure and rules (with applicable NBIAA guidelines) will govern play. Net Height 2.43M.
- 3) All round-robin matches are two straight game matches, while all playoff matches are best two of three matches. All games are played to except the deciding set which is played to 15 points (win by 2).
- 4) Volleyball New Brunswick certified officials will be used as major officials for all matches.
- 5) Following round-robin play, the top two teams in each pool will advance to the playoff round. Teams finishing 1st in each pool will be ranked 1st-3rd (based on games won/lost followed by points for/against) **Top 2 will receive a bye to the Semi-Finals.
- Teams finishing 2nd in each pool will be ranked 4th-6th (based on games won/lost followed by points for/against).
- 6) All matches will be played at the Currie Center, either in the Rec Gym (1st floor) or the Performance Gym (4th floor).
- 7) Coaches, the Currie Center is a large building that has many programs operating during the weekend. Please ensure that your team bet manner at all times, and that they take care of their garbage either as spectators in the stands or as players in the bench area after \$\epsilon\$**NOTE: The Control Centre will be located in the Performance Gym, where results will be posted and ice available in the event of an injury **NOTE: There will be an ADMISSION charge \$5 for DAY PASS / \$8 for WEEKEND PASS (students get in free).
