- Crysta Collicott provided an update for training and support that 8 teachers were able to participate with FEC in regards to supporting LGBTQ community within the school. Several initiatives will be integrated within the school, including activities protected under the Charter of Human Rights and Freedom. Already in place is a private/public washroom with appropriate signage to allow individuals the ability to choose regardless of gender identity.
