This week I would like to provide you with some introductory information on what a Pow Wow is.

I will also include a short video clip on two of the Traditional Pow Wow dances.

#### What is a Pow Wow?

Pow Wow's are ceremonial celebrations of cultural pride for all ages and provide an opportunity for Indigenous communities to gather, celebrate, commemorate and learn from each other. These dynamic events showcase the music, dance, regalia, food and crafts of Indigenous peoples and nations from across Canada.

Locally the first Pow Wow of the season is held at UNB Fredericton's Currie Center. Most Pow Wows take place outside however the one at the Currie Center is inside. Unfortunately, due to the Pandemic, the Pow Wow was not held this year. Throughout the summer months several First Nations communities host Pow Wow's in New Brunswick and across Canada.

### What is Regalia?

Often people refer to the Traditional outfits worn by participants at a Pow Wow as "costumes". This term is incorrect.

The appropriate term to use is "Regalia".
