### **Growth Mindset: More Ideas for Creating a Growth Mindset at Home**

**Dealing with the STRUGGLE**

Help your child become curious about errors or lack of success.

Remind your child that failure is important on the way to success.

Model this!

Show your child the Michael Jordan *Failure* commercial (available at

<https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=-45mMioJ5szc> and only 30 seconds

long). Talk to your child about what the last line of the video means.

Provide some puzzles and games that may create a little struggle for your child. Work together and discuss why struggle shows that you are learning and that you can build resiliency.

Model and encourage resiliency – the ability to bounce back from errors and failures.
