### Learning and the Brain

- Talk about neural networking. Ask your child what he or she has learned in school about the brain.
- Whenever you hear your child say "I give up" or "I just don't get this," remind your child to visualize neurons connecting every time he learns something new.
- Encourage your child to work hard and practice new skills and concepts so that he or she can develop strong neural connections in his/her brain.
- Share with your child some things that you have not yet mastered and your plan for practicing and building stronger connections in your brain.
