HELP HELP! Once again our school and PSSC ask for your help in helping to keep our students be safe at Hubbard. The student drop of area is a busy spot in and around the parking lot. Our PSSC is working on easing the flow of traffic, but in the meantime as drivers you need to follow the arrows out there, and watch for students. Here is what will help:

- ⇒ There are TWO LANES at the parking lot drop off.
- ⇒ DROP OFF IS ON THE INSIDE LANE, students get out and walk along the building, keep moving along the lane and please don't park or idle
- DO NOT DROP YOUR CHILD OFF IN THE OUTSIDE LANE. If you need to stop your car, go park and walk with your child. Your child should never be expected to cross over the path of a vehicle. There have been close calls.

- ⇒ Please do not use the staff parking area off of Mackenzie Ave. to drop off students. It is not deemed a drop off site.

- ⇒ Mind the bus loading area. Keep it clear for buses only.
