What a busy and exciting time it has been for students and staff as we moved from Hubbard 1.0 over the past week to our new location on Drummond Drive, Hubbard 2.0. Approximately 1400 boxes were filled and emptied, 400 large totes were used, 600 bags for student belongings, a gym, and approximately 20 rooms and hallways saw fresh paint, countless bulletin boards were prepared, whiteboards installed, a wall was built and new technology put in place. The movers were busy for 4 days steady! To further update you, water, air and fire inspections have taken place. New hydration stations are in place as are bussing and vehicle routines. Our COVID control tape and arrows are lining the halls and health safety has been considered. We ask for your cooperation in parking areas which are limited and that are shared spaces at the beginning and end of the day. Visitor parking by the building is from 9-2 Monday to Thursday and from 9-11 on Fridays.

I want to say a huge thank you to our staff who have worked super long hours, packing and unpacking to make the 'first day' of school a positive experience for your children. District maintenance, cleaners, facilities, and IT teams were invaluable. Everyone has worked tirelessly on this project! We appreciated your partnership and look forward to establishing new routines at Hubbard, where even new school signs show our Hurricane pride! With several shelves waiting to be assembled, some boxes and a library yet to be organized, we are open for business!

It's time to get down to work again, with our now seasoned Hurricanes in Grade 3 facing greater expectations, our Grade 4 reading provincial assessments around the corner, and Grade 5 students who will be expected to push to be ready for the challenges of Middle School. On April 6 your child will receive their report cards for term 2. We will review expectations and practice new routines in this third reporting period.
