





## Dates and Information to Note:

### Student and Staff Absences


Our school like many others is experiencing increased staffing shortages and absences due to illness. Thank you for understanding that routines during the day differ as we backfill teachers from within the school when a substitute is not available or when we have several new guest teachers. **Staff, like students are encouraged to remain at home when actively sick.** We appreciate your efforts to monitor your child's health and ask that you continue to keep children at home when they are ill. COVID 19 has recently been added to the Communicable Disease Exclusion list. **If your child has COVID, it is expected that they will remain home until symptoms are improved and until they are fever free (without medication) for 24 hours.**

### Student Performance and Report Cards

Term 2 **Report Cards** will be sent home on April 11th. Prior to this date, teachers will communicate with you the dates, times and format for interviews. This term, in person interviews are possible, should you wish to come to school as for many of you, it will be the first time in our building! Telephone or virtual interviews are also possible. Teachers have worked hard to meet students 'where they are' in learning and move students forward. The report cards will reflect the concepts taught at this point in the year, understanding that we have experienced several disruptions to in person learning. Please make a point to meet or speak with your child's teacher to discuss progress and next steps. **See the calendar for interview dates and times.**
