Truth and Reconciliation Day & Orange Shirt Day is tomorrow, Sept. 30th. This day, held every year in Canada marks a day to remember residential school survivors from First Nations communities. This year, we remember too the thousands of children who didn't return home from residential schools across the country. At Hubbard we show our support for our First Nation classmates and students whose families were affected. We want to ensure that we are helping to pass learning on to the next generations-because indeed, EVERY CHILD MATTERS! Thank you Mr. Foley for your classroom visits and teachings!

Our <u>Terry Fox Walk</u> will take place on Friday, October 8th around our school property and surrounding area to show our support for this worthwhile cause. Donations are accepted until that day. For every Loonie donated, students get a chance to win a prize! It feels good to help out! Our goal is to raise \$450.00.

<u>Creating Safer Schools</u> During the month of October, every year, students are engaged in safety protocols for fire drills, bus safety/evacuations and secure the building exercises. Although these events can heighten concern, it compares little to the concern of not knowing what to do in the event of a real situation. Our team of teachers and support staff work hard to make students comfortable with practice so we will know how to respond if needed. Bus and Fire safety weeks are noted on the calendar. Safe school practices will take place all month, with drills conducted throughout the year. Today, during arrival we had a false alarm fire bell. Students and staff with your help kept students supervised outside of the school until the all clear sounded.

Student Drop Off/Pick Up and Safety: We Need Your Help! Over the course of the last few weeks we have been fine tuning our dismissal and drop of routines for your child's safety. An outstanding concern remains STUDENT PICK UP BY VEHICLE at day's when there are many vehicles in the laneway. Students who are being picked up will be dismissed and supervised by staff members while they wait for you. Please see below:

- The lane is one way with a small passing area in front of the school. Drivers are to use one lane only for pick-up and be very cautious if you are moving around a vehicle. Follow the arrows for entrance and exit, please.
- 2. Please remain in your car when picking up your child. Parking in the lot, or along the road impedes the flow of traffic, including busses. If you are meeting your child by foot, please arrange to do so at the far left of the building by the playaround/aym corner.
- At Pick Up time, please pull up to the corner of the building (gym) and your child will be walked to your vehicle. This allows for more vehicles to be in the lane and not waiting on the road.

Thanks in advance for your patience and cooperation as we protect your child's safety.

<u>COVID Safety:</u> Please be mindful about not sending your child to school if they are sick to prevent the spread of germs and potentially Covid illness. Teachers have sent home a packet of learning in the event that our school has to revert to at home learning for a short time. All of our decisions are made with/by public health. Students require two masks (the type that fits around chin and over nose) and a water bottle. Thanks.
