Relocation News: In case you did not read the news sent home by your child's teacher, a decision has been made to have our school remain at the Drummond Drive location for ALL of next school year, eliminating the challenges faced with our move mid-year. Discussions are also being had around a permanent relocation to Hubbard 2.0.

Public Health Safety First! These days have us all on edge with the rise of incidents and the variant COVID strains that are in our region. Please ensure that your child has a supply of properly fitted masks. Buff/neck masks are not recommended for the safety of your child and others. We continue to maintain sanitizing stations at school and mask wearing in common areas, but we have had many students coming without masks or needing lots of reminders to put them on, or wear them properly. Please help us by having a conversation at home about following the guidelines for everyone's health. For the most part students have been stellar and have shown great care this year.

Arrival and Dismissal: Our supervision begins in the morning at 7:50 which is the earliest time that students who are being dropped off or walking to school should arrive. Students are sometimes being dropped off unsupervised as early as 7:30. Please stay within the boundaries of supervised times as staff are not always in place any earlier. We appreciate your understanding in securing childcare for your children in the morning as we would hate to see a student unsupervised and something happen. A BIG thanks for our parent chauffeurs who are picking up students at the end of the day. Your cooperation has been so appreciated.
