FDSA Soccer program is a program that is coached by two UNB students who are involved in the UNB soccer program and play both nationally and internationally. MAS has received a grant from the Provincial Government in order to support this Six week program.

RTI (Response to Intervention) has begun this month. Four days a week for half an hour in the morning some students go to the gym for extra Physical Education while other students stay in the class to work on a one to one basis or in small groups with their teacher. Throughout RTI, students who require extra support receive help, students that are at an appropriate grade level also receive extra help to further enhance their learning, and finally students that are doing well get an enrichment opportunity. Eventually all students get a chance to go to the gym for extra Physical Education with a focus to provide opportunities for teachers and students to work together in a small setting in order to further meet the learning needs of our students.
