SPECIAL NOTE:

Two scholarships, will be awarded to High School graduates from Holy Rosary Parish (one scholarship for each of the two graduates) who will be continuing their education after High School. Each of the two scholarships is \$250.00 per year for the number of years the student remains in an educational program after High School, up to a maximum of 4 years, for a total maximum of \$1000.00. The awarding of these two scholarships each year is not automatic. Successful candidates will be chosen by our Holy Rosary Parish Scholarship Committee and based on the following criteria:

- a) The need for financial assistance. (Kept strictly confidential)
- b) Scholastic achievement.
- c) An active member of our parish and practising their faith.
- d) Involvement and contribution in the community; specifically family, parish, school, and the community in general.

Each Scholarship is awarded to a student with the condition that the student actually attends the educational institution of his or her choice. The scholarship will be sent directly to the institution of the student's choice each year (for a maximum of 4 years) after the registrar of the institution sends to our parish written verification that the student is registered in the program for the current year. The successful candidates for these two scholarships from our parish will receive an envelope representing the scholarship with a congratulatory letter during the High School Graduation Exercises.
