THE W. G. BISHOP NURSING HOME SCHOLARSHIPS FOR CHIPMAN AND MINTO GRADUATING STUDENTS

The Board of Directors of the W. G. Bishop Nursing Home voted in 1999 to increase their annual scholarships to Chipman Forest Avenue School and Minto Memorial High School to \$500 for each school. The reason for the two five hundred dollar scholarships is to encourage graduating students from our region to pursue health care careers.

Each of the high school principals in Chipman and Minto will decide each year if the scholarship is to be \$500 for one student or two \$250 scholarships for two students. The Principal of each of the high schools will inform the CEO of the Nursing Home of that decision. The scholarships will only be paid out by the W. G. Bishop Nursing Home upon confirmation of attendance by the students at the post secondary institution of their own choice.

The nursing home asks that the bursary be awarded to a deserving student who is enrolled in one of the three programs:

1. Bachelor of Nursing

- 2. Licensed Practical Nurse Program or
- 3. Geriatric or Health Care Aide Program

The selection committee at each high school shall be the one as structured by the Principal of the school. This Scholarship form will be posted and students must apply in writing, stating, to the committee, their suitability for this Scholarship.

The decision of each high school scholarship committee shall be final.
