

# ARTS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM



Find out everything you need to know to apply!

The **Arts Scholarships Program** is designed to recognize and encourage New Brunswick students who have demonstrated exceptional artistic talent and potential, and who are pursuing a career in the arts.

This program awards scholarships of up to:

- **\$2,500 per year for full-time post-secondary studies OR**
- **\$1,000 per year for part-time or short-term studies**

Applicants may pursue studies in architecture, arts administration, creative writing, dance, film and media, fine craft, literary translation, music, photography, theatre, visual arts and more.

## ELIGIBILITY

Only **New Brunswick residents** are eligible to receive funding. A resident is defined as a Canadian citizen or landed immigrant who has resided in New Brunswick for at least one year immediately preceding the application deadline.

## HOW TO APPLY

All applicants will be asked to submit the following:

- Description of the course or program including tuition fees
- Resume and official transcript
- Portfolio of recent artistic work (images, text or audio/video)
- 350-word description of the applicant's professional career plans
- Two (2) mandatory letters of recommendation.
