**Thursday:**


- Hero in a Mask Day (wear hero masks, hero costumes or our frontline workers are heroes too- police, nurse etc.)

Each class will be a team and will come up with a “Maskerade” team spirit name and will wear a colored buff for the week (provided). Activities will be all done by class this year and will be team building activities.

-Morning Announcements.... Every morning clues will be given as we play...guess the masked media character. Students record their answer and send it to the office to win 5 points for their team.



- Starting Wednesday, students can bid on a pie that will be thrown at staff members willing to do this. There will be one real pie auctioned off per willing staff. Bids will be placed online in the same way we did the Christmas auction. The winner will be declared on Thursday by 12 pm and will be invited to the library on Friday to throw the pie.

- The basketball challenge will take place at 2:00 in the gym. Each Gr. 5 class will have 5 minutes to shoot as many baskets from the red line as possible. Any staff can also compete, and standings will be given at 2:30.

- Price is Right- Each class will have a turn to bid on a prize and the winners will visit the office one at a time to play a Price is Right game and then they will spin the wheel. Whoever gets closest to 100 can play for the big prize package at the end. We will do 2 rounds- K-2 and 3-5. Two students will play off in the end and the winner will get a big prize and the runner up will get a consolation prize.

-Fear Factor- Each room will receive a masked-up dessert. There will be enough for each student to eat the dessert. Students do not have to eat it. The number of students who accept the challenge will determine points. The game will start at 10:30 on Friday.

- Masked Dancer- a student (or group of students) from each class can be selected to dance and will be called on starting at 11:00 to come to the office for their dance and of course they will wear their mask for this. Dances should only be 1 min or less.

“Amasking” Race Challenge- a clue package will be provided for classes full of masked riddles to solve and complete.

Mask in Action- classes will receive a class challenge to work through. Each class gets one roll of school toilet paper to create the most creative masked mummy.

Points...dress up points 1 point for each person dressed up in your team

Game points....1st place is 10pts, 2nd place is 7pts, 3rd place is 5 pts.
