









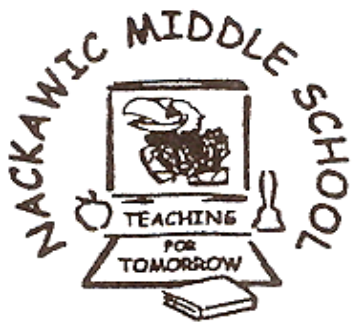

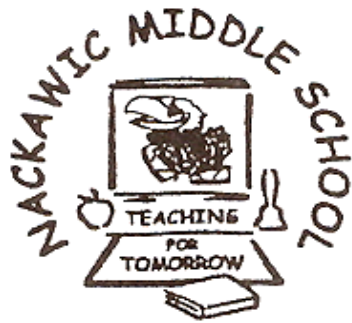


Dance will take place in the downstairs common area. The cafeteria and gym will also be open for student's use. Snacks and drinks will be available for purchase.

Public Health nurses will be holding an immunization clinic at our school on Monday September 28<sup>th</sup>.

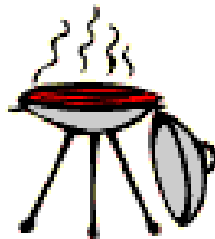

**The market will be open for students to purchase ice cream and other goodies.**

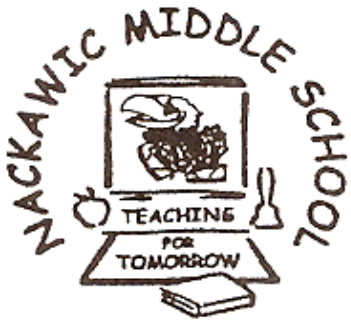

Looking to increase effectiveness and decrease stress? Check out Stephen Covey's 7 Habits of Highly Effective Habits:



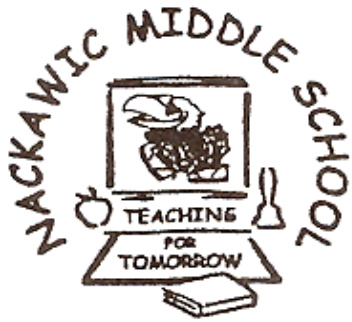
- [Habit 1: Be proactive](#): You're in charge of yourself
