Task #2

- The goal is to find as many items from the vocabulary list as possible by taking a picture.
- Each picture can be taken individually or if you want to be creative you could have a one photo.
- Once you have found all of your items you must label each photo with the proper vocabulary word. You can use this by adding a text to your photo on your device, use a piece of paper and hold it up next to the object, or you can use PowerPoint or word if that is an option for you.
