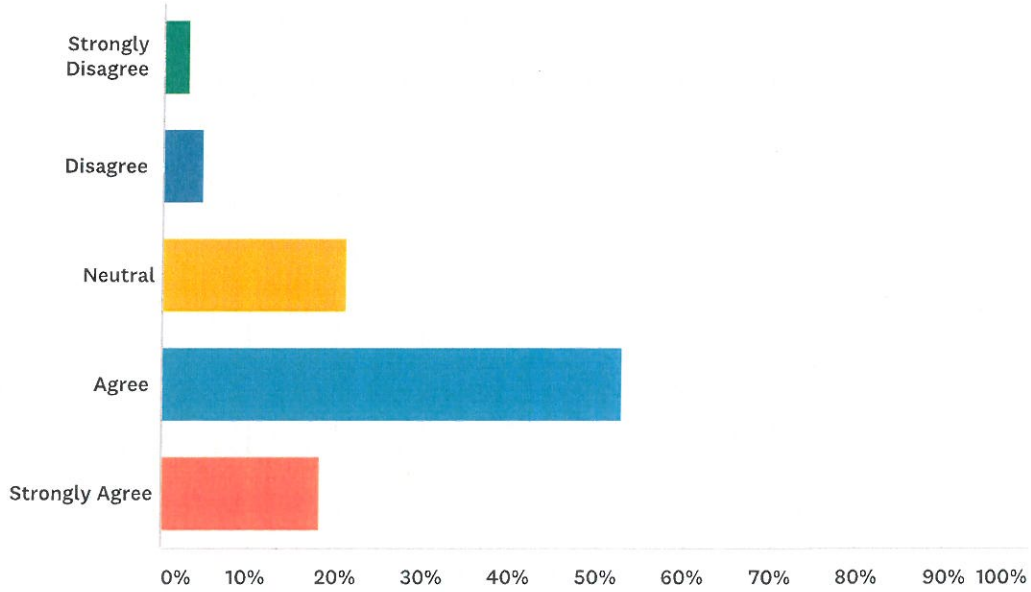


Q1 Do you agree that your child's classroom teacher sets high expectations?

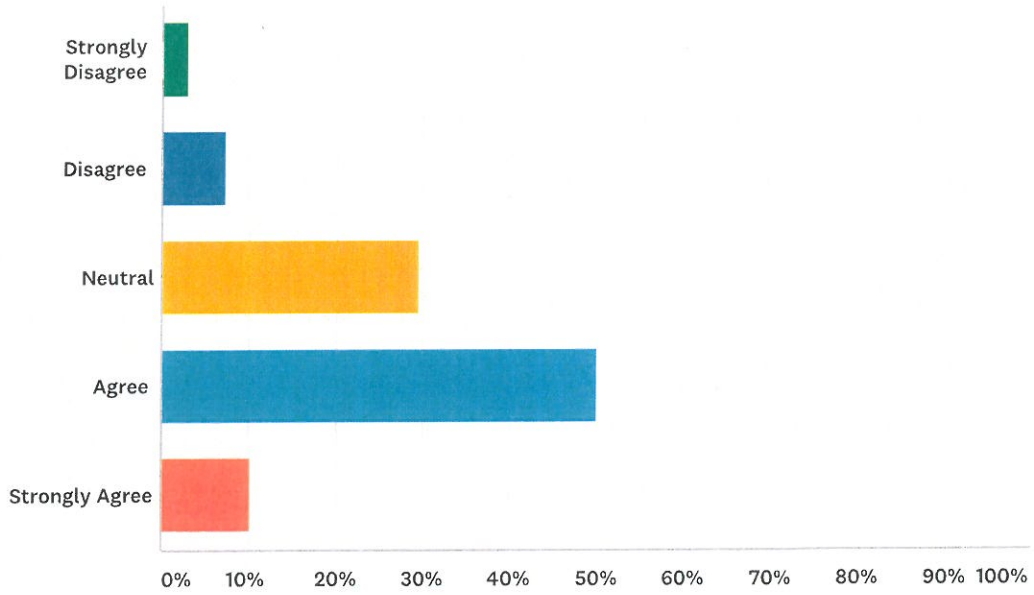

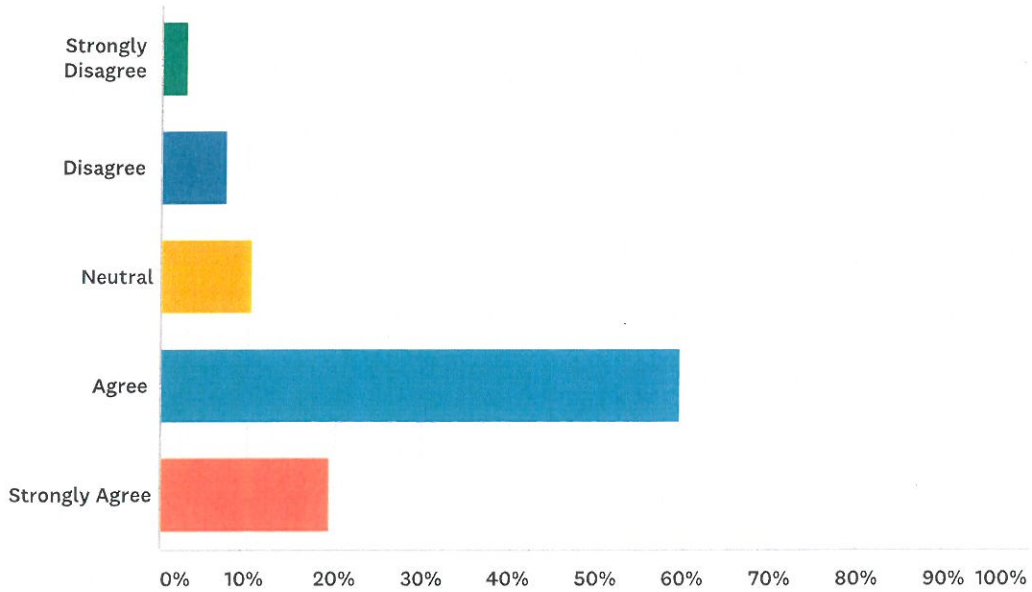

Q3 As a parent, I understand the academic expectations set by the school?

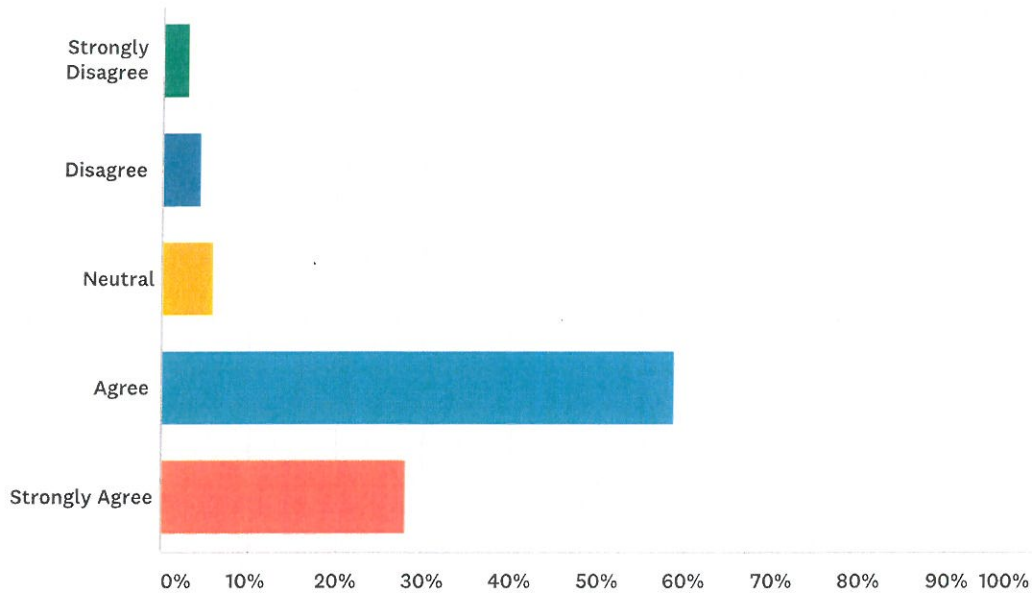

Q4 As a parent, I understand the behavioural expectations set by the school?

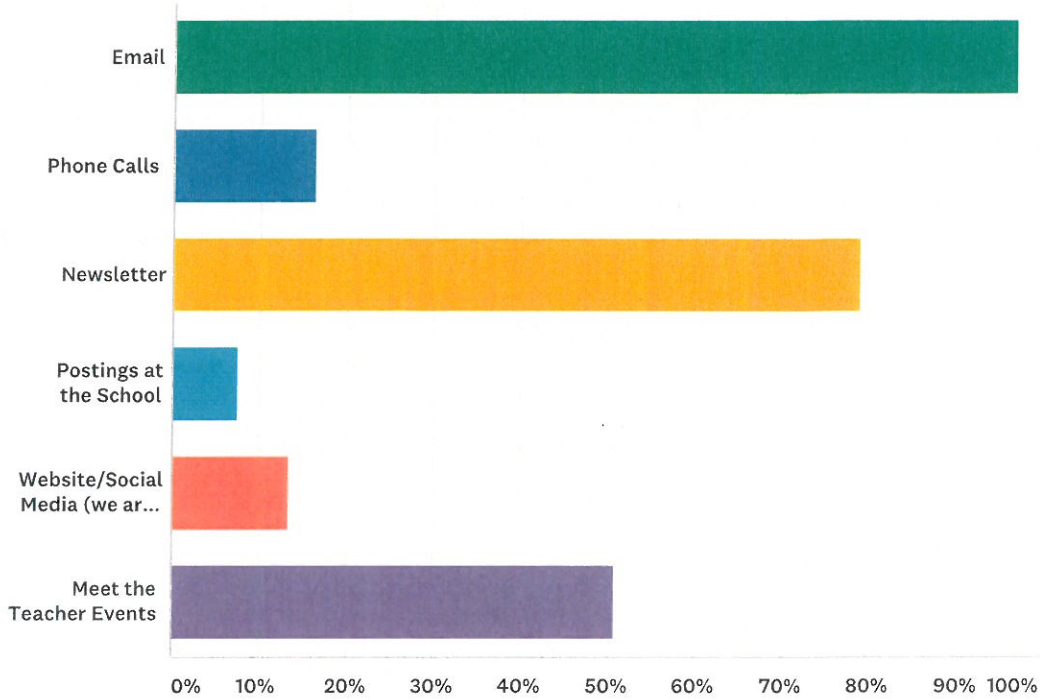

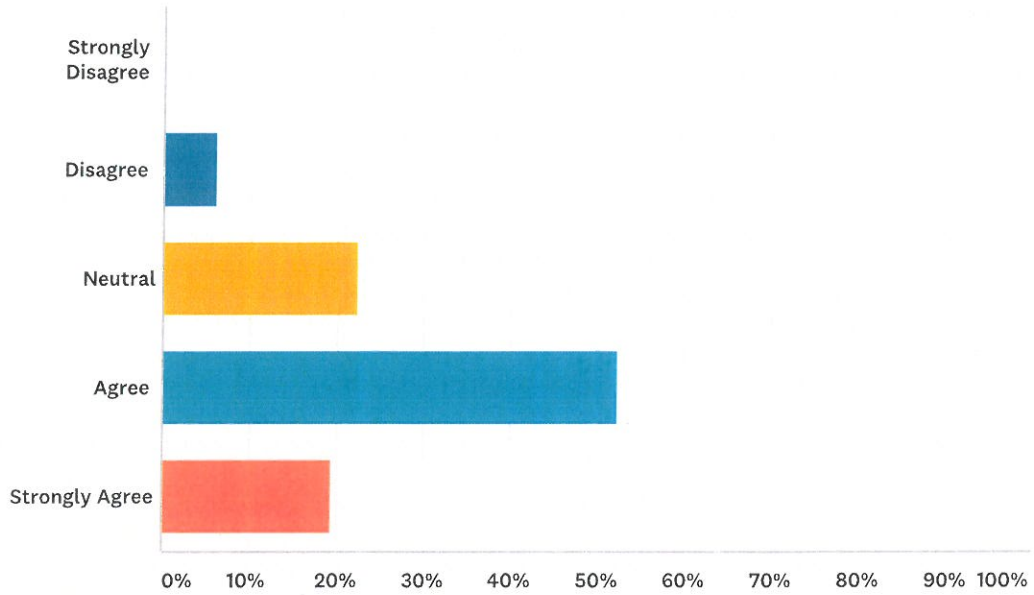

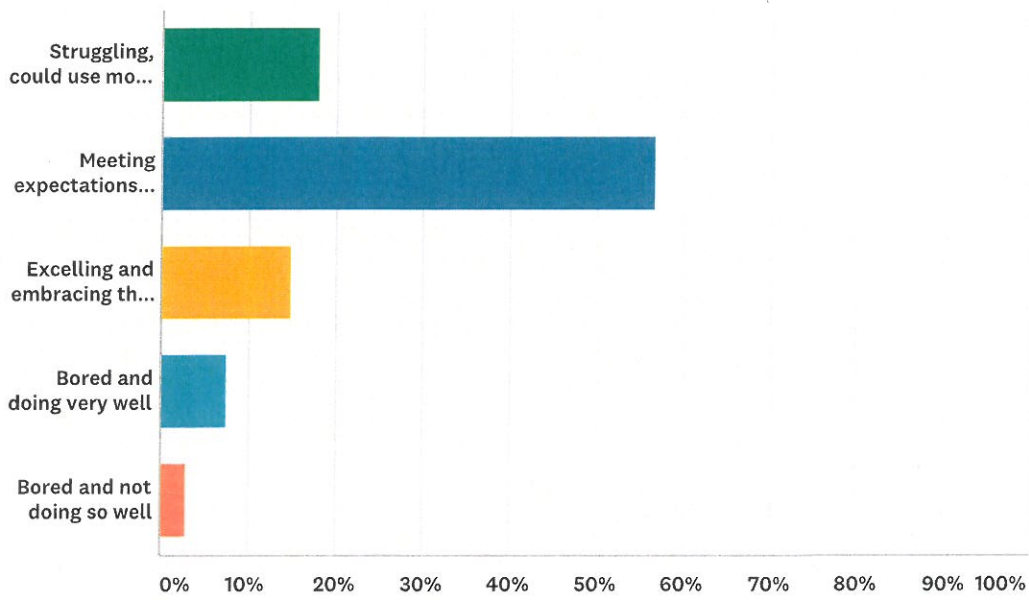

Q7 How is your child finding the curriculum?

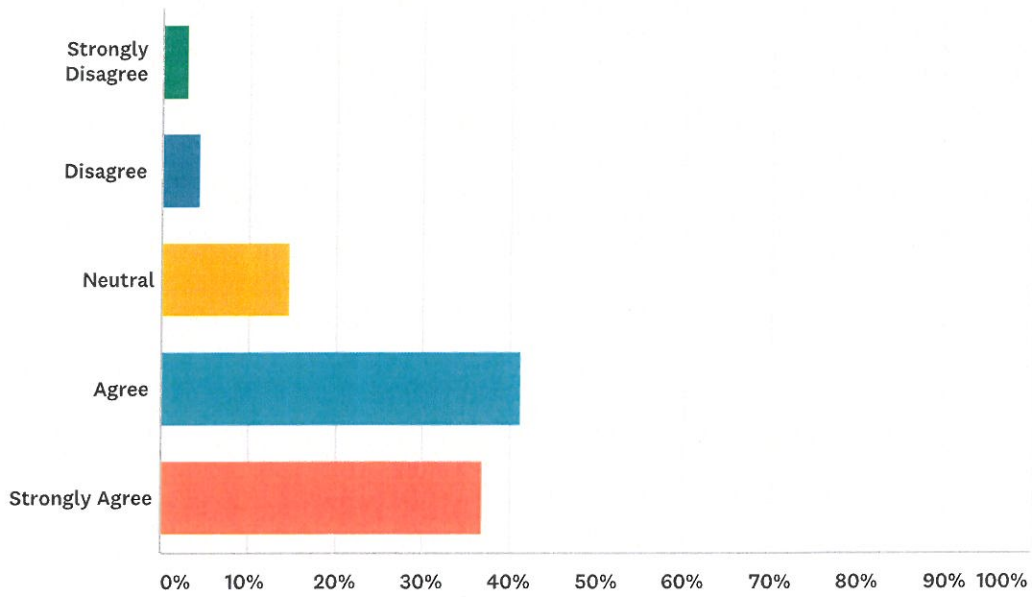

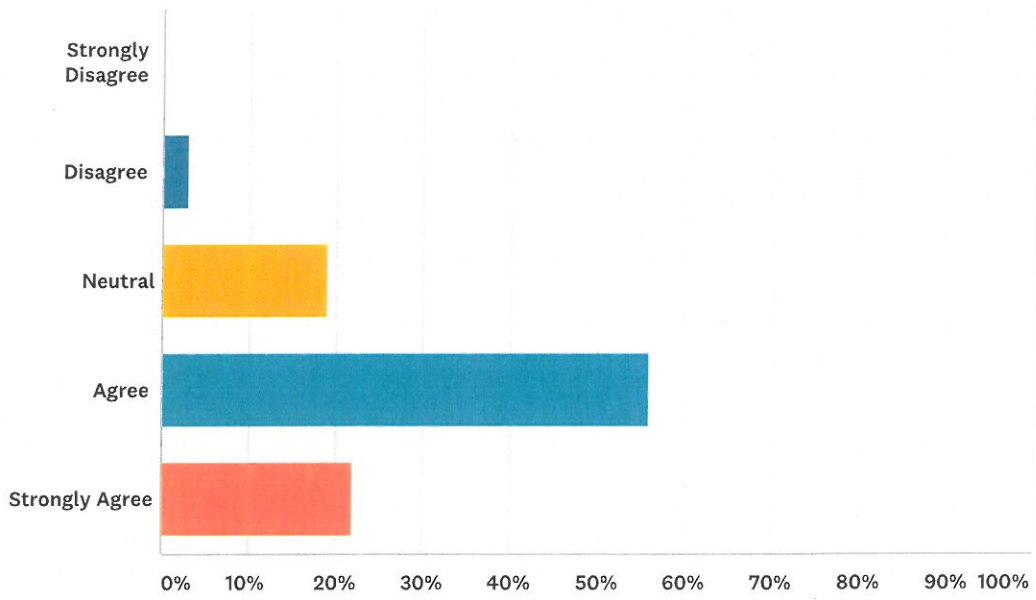

Q9 The school, in general, communicates well with me as a parent.

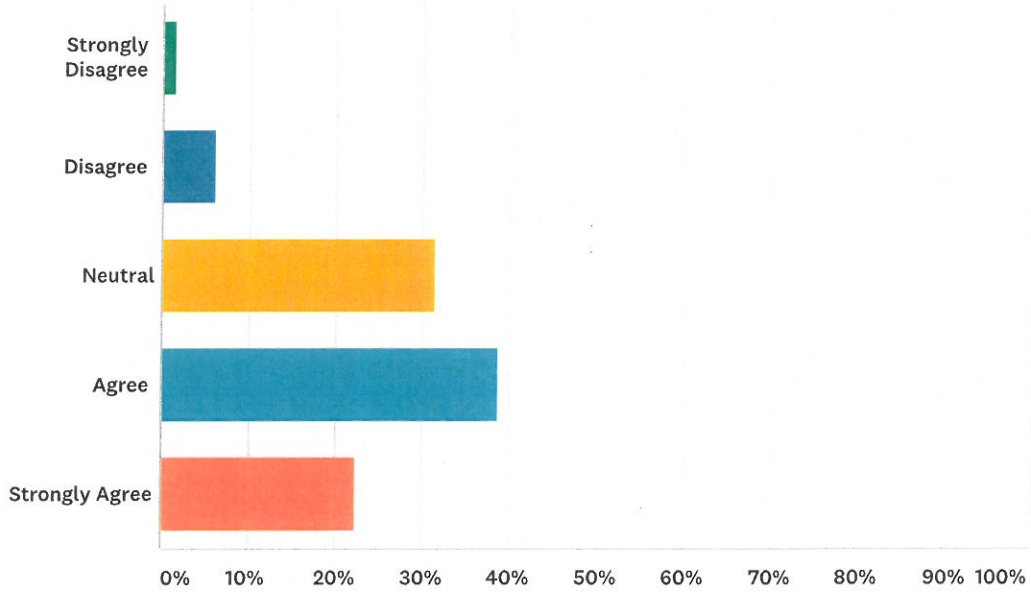

Q10 When I have addressed a conflict at the classroom teacher level, I feel it has been resolved satisfactorily.

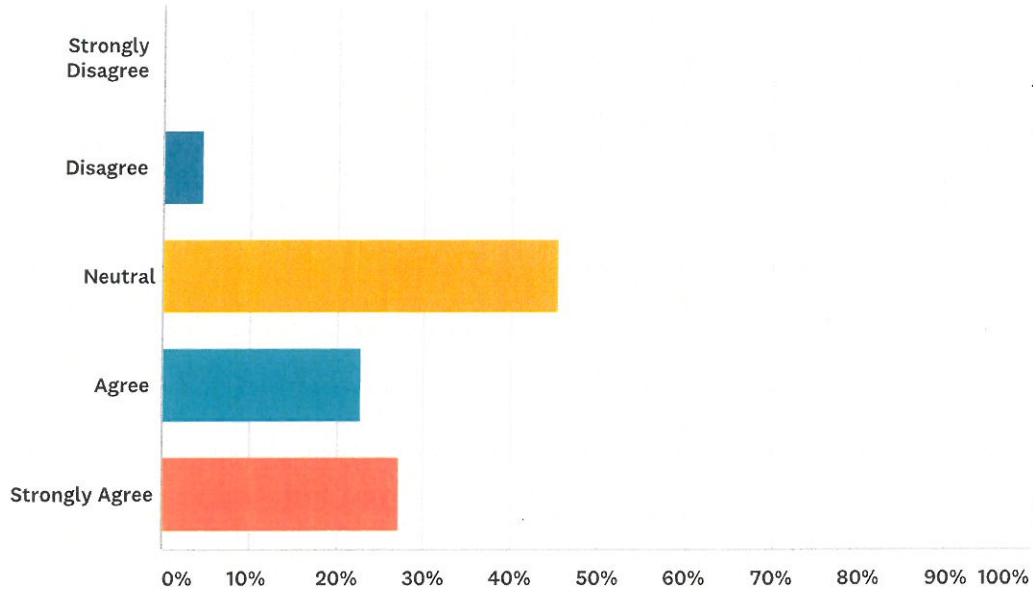

Q11 When I have addressed a conflict at the administration level (principal, vice-principal), I feel it has been resolved satisfactorily.

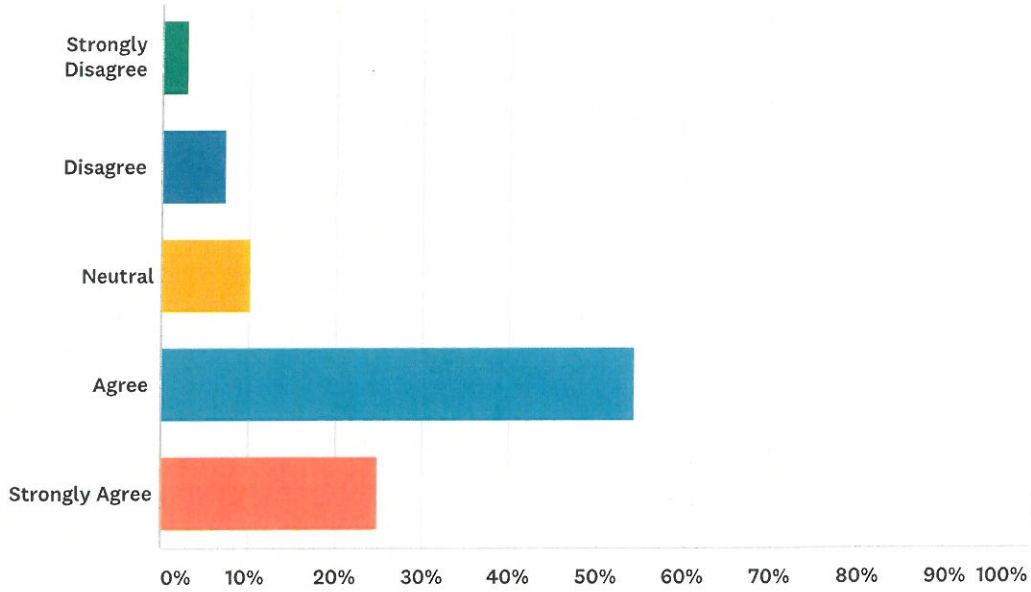

Q12 I have confidence in the school's ability to communicate in response to an emergency.

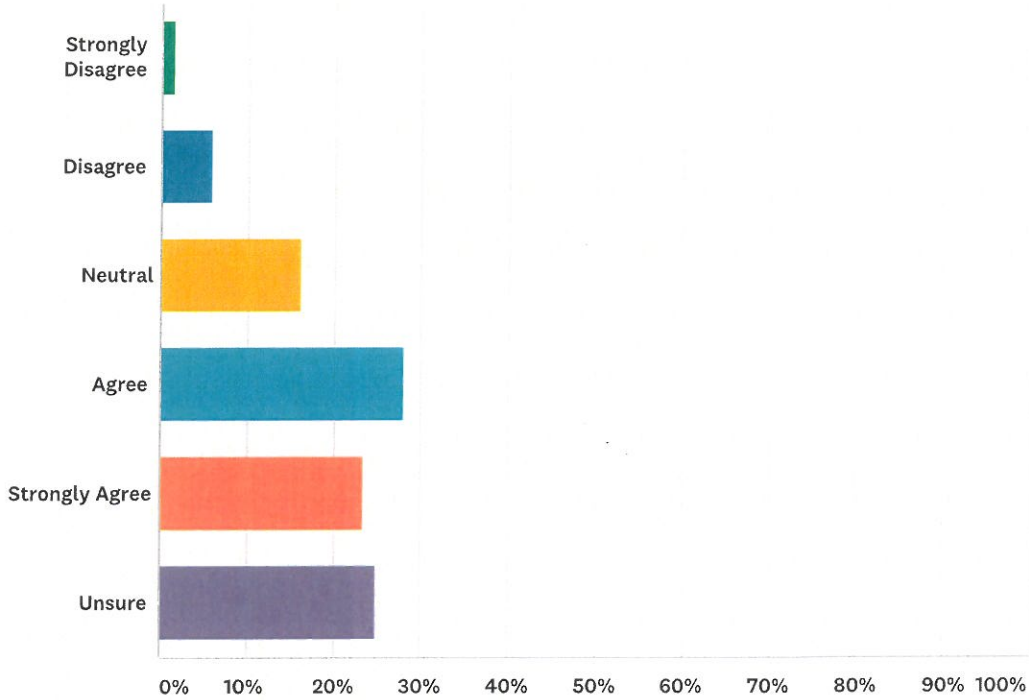

Given that each of the 6 teachers has told me a different policy, it is clear that the teachers themselves have no idea what the policy actually is, or they are relying on outdated policies. The other challenge when it comes to security is that my wife can enter the school and have nobody question her at all, whereas I, a father, am questioned (sometimes) when I walk down the halls with my child. Yes, it's understood that most pedophiles / criminals are male, however when it's clear that I'm walking with my child down the hall beside me, I would suggest that either everybody questions me or nobody questions me.
