Next we stired the yummy ingredients together and made sure it tasted right and then stired it some more with a big long spoon.

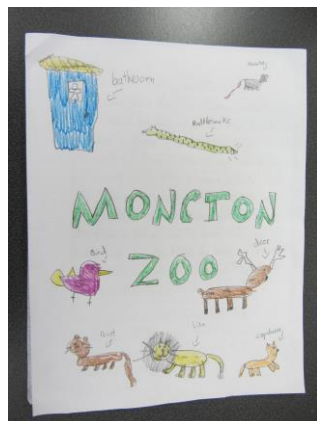
Then we washed our hands again, and took the delicious dough out and rolled it out with a big old roller. It was hard.
