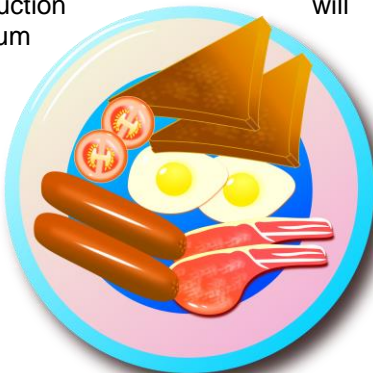
Donation Request
