Dear Parents/Guardians of Students at Bath Elementary and Middle Schools,

As stated in my October 29th, 2014 letter to the parents of Bath Middle School and in my letter of January 23rd, 2015 to the parents of both Bath Middle and Bath Elementary Schools, the Anglophone West School District Education Council (ASD-W DEC) voted in favor of engaging a sustainability study of the Bath Schools, under the process of Provincial Policy 409: Multi-year Infrastructure Planning. The sustainability study of a school follows a process that includes three public meetings.

On February 19th, I wrote to you with an invitation to attend Public Meeting #2, scheduled for March 26, 2015. I write to you today with a change in date for this meeting. You might recall that this meeting will provide an opportunity for parents, PSSC and stakeholders to present their ideas regarding the sustainability of Bath Elementary and Middle Schools in a public forum. Details of the meeting are included in that February 19th letter, which can also be found on our website in the Bath Sustainability Study section.

The DEC plans to conclude the study with a motion and vote at their regular public meeting on **Thursday, April 23, 2015, in Edmundston**. This meeting will be streamed into Bath Middle School.
