Dear Parents/Guardians of Students at Bath Elementary and Middle Schools,

As stated in my October 29<sup>th</sup>, 2014 letter to the parents of Bath Middle School and in my letter of January 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2015 to the parents of both Bath Middle and Bath Elementary Schools, the Anglophone West School District Education Council (ASD-W DEC) voted in favor of engaging a sustainability study of the Bath Schools, under the process of Provincial Policy 409: Multi-year Infrastructure Planning. The sustainability study of a school follows a process that includes three public meetings.

Parents and members of the community are invited to attend the public meeting in the consultation process on the sustainability of Bath Elementary School.

At this meeting, district staff will describe the process and outline facts about Bath Elementary School, as guided by Policy 409. This meeting will follow a similar format to the meeting that took place on December 11, 2014, specific to Bath Middle School. A follow-up public meeting will be held on **Thursday, March 26, 2015**, where parents and stakeholders may present ideas on the sustainability of the schools in the Community of Bath. The DEC plans to conclude the study with a motion and vote at their regular public meeting on **Thursday, April 23, 2015**. This meeting will be streamed into Bath Middle School from St. Mary's Academy in Edmundston, (site of the regularly scheduled Public DEC Meeting).
