Hi Marty,

Here is the information you requested:

Enrollment at Burton Elementary: GrK = 12, Gr1 = 14, Gr2 = 17

Enrollment at Assiniboine Elementary from the Community of Burton: GrK = 9 (8 of these in current Assiniboine catchment area, 1 from Burton catchment area), Gr1 = 14 (9 of these in current Assiniboine catchment area, 5 from Burton catchment area), Gr2 = 5 (3 of these in current Assiniboine catchment area, 2 from Burton catchment area)

Enrollment at Hubbard Elementary from the Community of Burton: Gr3 = 29 {6 of these in current Hubbard catchment area (2-FI, 4-Eng) and 23 from Burton catchment area (10-FI, 13-Eng)}, Gr4 = 27 {6 of these in current Hubbard catchment area (1-FI, 5-Eng) and 21 from Burton catchment area (4-FI, 17-Eng)}, Gr5 = 25 {3 of these in current Hubbard catchment area (3-Eng) and 22 from Burton catchment area (22-Eng)}.

There is one student from the Burton catchment area attending Gr5FI at Summerhill. There is one student from the Burton catchment area attending Gr2 at Gesner.

There is nobody with a Swan Creek address attending school at Burton, Assiniboine or Hubbard. There are 9 kids from Swan Creek who attend grades K-5 at Gagetown School (K=1, each other grade=2).
