Dear Parents/Guardians of Students at Bath Community School:

As stated in my September 20th, 2019 letter to you, the Anglophone West School District Education Council (ASD-W DEC) voted in favor of engaging a sustainability study of Bath Community School, under the process of Provincial Policy 409: Multi-year Infrastructure Planning. The sustainability study of a school follows a process that includes three public meetings.

Parents and members of the community are invited to attend the first public meeting in the consultation process on the sustainability of Bath Community School:

***The 9:00AM start for Bath Community School is a change from the previously scheduled 10:00AM start in order to accommodate those who wish to attend the local community Christmas parade.**

Florenceville Elementary School, Florenceville Middle School and Bristol Elementary School are also being studied under the parameters of Provincial Policy 409. The Bristol Elementary School Public Meeting #1 will also take place on Saturday, November 30, 2019, at Bristol Elementary at 1:00PM. The Florenceville Elementary and Middle Schools first public meetings took place on Saturday, October 26, 2019.

At Public Meeting #1, district staff will describe the process and outline facts about Bath Community School, as guided by Policy 409. A second public meeting will be held on Saturday, January 25, 2020, where parents and stakeholders may present ideas on the sustainability of the schools. Other opportunities to provide feedback are also available, with details on our website at www.asd-w.nbed.nb.ca, following the sustainability study links. Relevant documentation is also posted to this site throughout the study.
