Dear Parents/Guardians of Students at Bath Community School, Bristol Elementary School, Florenceville Elementary School and Florenceville Middle School:

As stated in my September 20th, 2019 letter to you, the Anglophone West School District Education Council (ASD-W DEC) voted in favor of engaging a sustainability study of Bath Community School, Bristol Elementary School, Florenceville Elementary School and Florenceville Middle School, under the process of Provincial Policy 409: Multi-year Infrastructure Planning. The sustainability study of a school follows a process that includes three public meetings.

The series of first public meetings in these studies were held on Saturday, October 26, 2019 (two Florenceville schools) and Saturday, November 30, 2019 (Bath and Bristol schools). At those times, I described the process of the study and outlined facts about the corresponding individual school, as guided by Policy 409. The presentation from those meetings can be found on our ASD-W website (www.asd-w.nbed.nb.ca) under the "Sustainability Studies" tab and by clicking on the school of interest. There are also other documents related to the study that are found here.

The second public meeting allows for parents and stakeholders to present their ideas on the sustainability of the school(s). Presentations can take any form and are meant for a public audience as well as members of the DEC. District staff will also be on hand. A simple registration form must be completed and submitted to the school/district one week in advance for planning purposes. Parents, community groups, stakeholders and members of the community are invited to present at the second public meeting in the consultation process on the sustainability of these schools:
