I also have a major concern regarding safety, my Youngest child (41/2/ears old) but will be starting school in the fall has ADHD. He has a hard enough time sitting still in a car with seat belts for short drives, And if he is made to change schools, he could be made to sit an hour and a half each way. That scare's me.

Finally, having to be a single parent most of the year it's hard enough finding enough hours in the day for Homework, baths, reading ect for 4 children. If they transfer I will have less than 3 hours with them before bed.

I know the school is small but to our family

it is a huge necessary.
