➤ **Sustainability Study – Florenceville Middle School – Meeting #1**

- Kimberley Douglass, District Education Chairperson, welcomed everyone to the first sustainability study meeting for Florenceville Middle School. Kimberley thanked the Principal of Florenceville Middle School for her hospitality. The Council toured the school prior to the meeting.
- The District Education Council (DEC) introduced themselves and provided the area in which they serve as a Councilor.
- David McTimoney, Superintendent of ASD-W, presented a power point presentation called Florenceville Middle School Sustainability Study. - The next public meeting for this sustainability study will be held at the Florenceville Middle School on **Saturday, January 18, 2020 at 10:00 a.m.** At that time, stakeholders will be given an opportunity to present to the DEC. A stakeholder registration form is posted on the Anglophone West School District website under Florenceville Middle School Sustainability Study tab. This document needs to be completed and sent to Carol Clark-Caterini one week prior to that meeting to present to the Council. The final meeting will be held on **Thursday, March 19, 2020** at Carleton North High School for the sustainability study of all four applicable schools.
- There are three possible outcomes for a sustainability study included in Policy 409 were discussed; to remain status quo (where the study is declared finished), to make a recommendation to the Minister of Education and Early Childhood Development to invest in repairs for the school, and thirdly, a recommendation to build a new school and close Florenceville Middle School.

- Transportation timeframe was brought forward – 10 km away to 90-minute ride home
- 55 years or more in New Brunswick
- McAdam / George – 1924 and 1928, oldest schools in ASD-W
- Status quo not really an option
- Cost comparison for old and new schools
