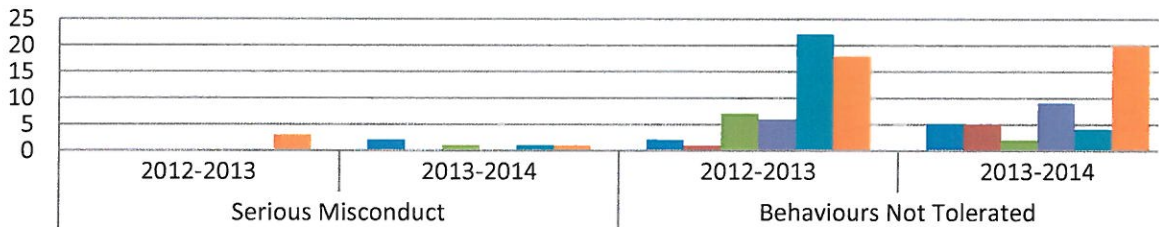

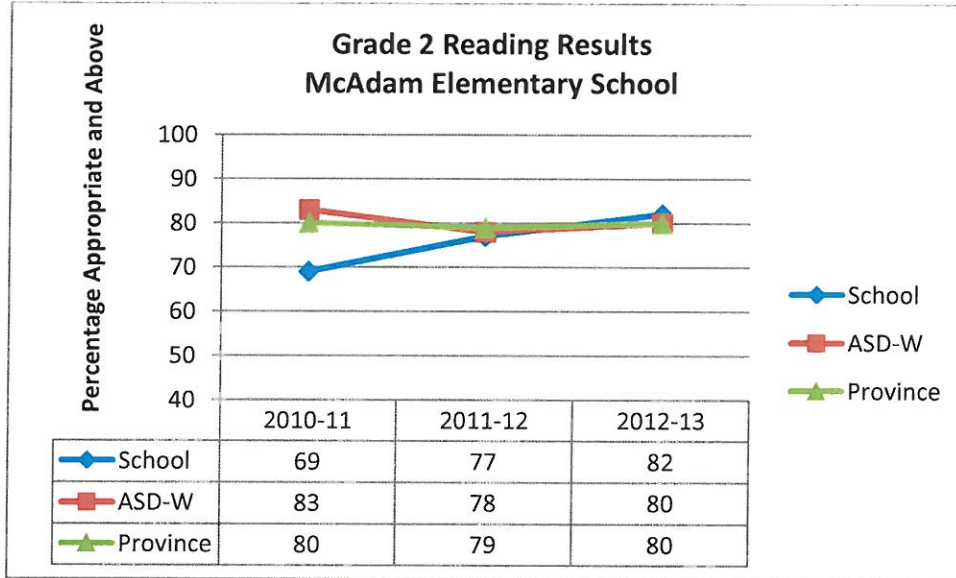

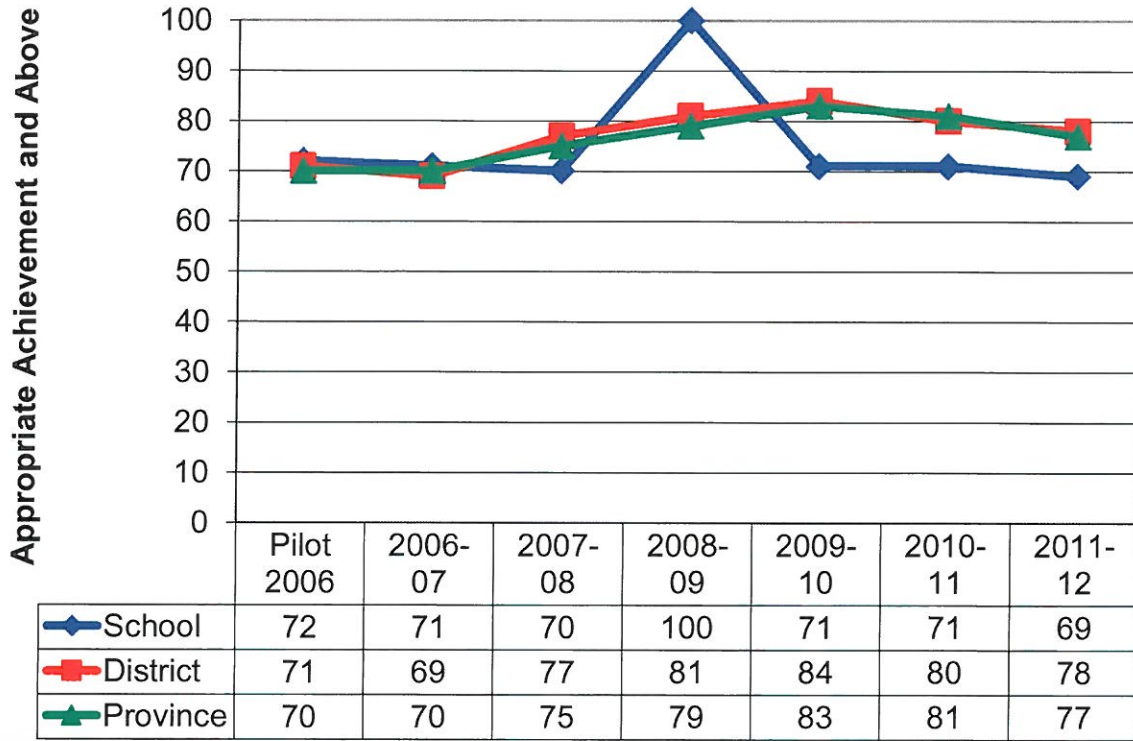

Reading Comprehension**

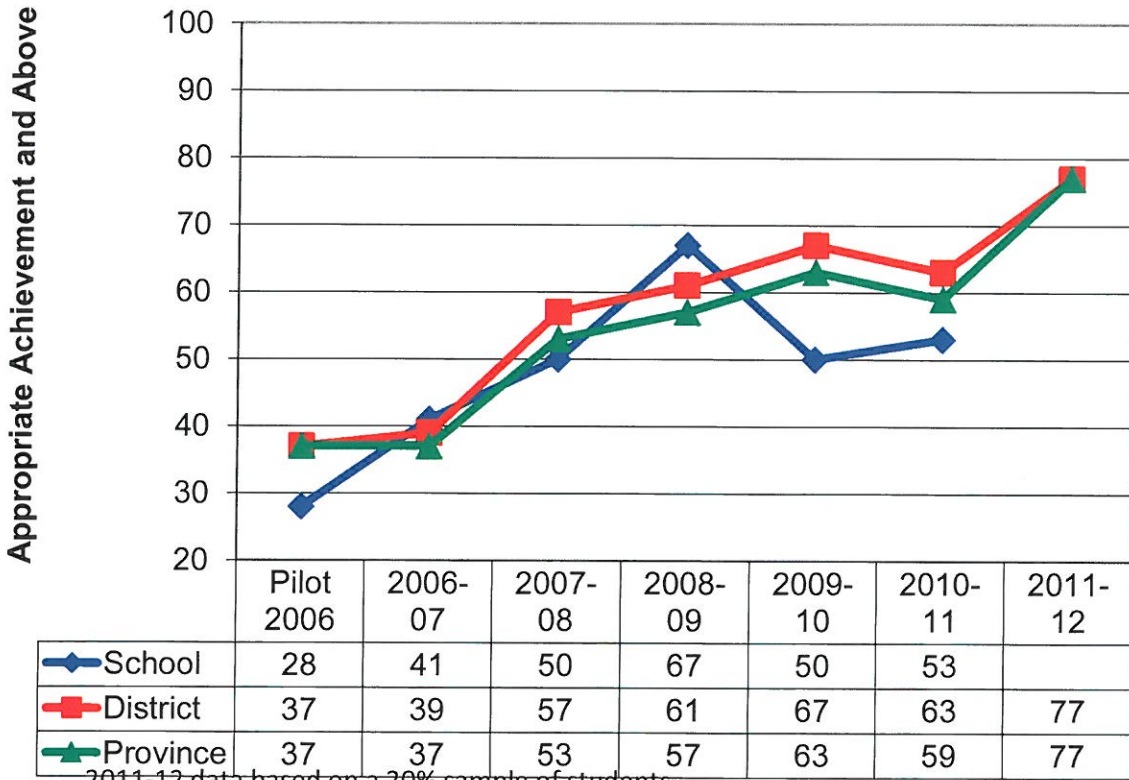
