Dear Minister Rousselle:

I am writing to inform you that the Anglophone West District Education Council met on January 28, 2016, to consider all required criteria pertaining to the sustainability of Nackawic Elementary School, Nackawic Middle School and Nackawic High School – as a cluster - under Provincial Policy 409 – Multi-year School Infrastructure Planning. The study was launched on May 21, 2015, and has followed the guidelines as outlined in Policy 409.

Following the public presentation of the enclosed executive summary, a motion was presented:

“...I would propose based on the economic development process in the community of Nackawic as outlined to us in the presentation that we maintain the status quo of all three Nackawic schools”

After a vote by Council, the motion was carried.

While Section 6.6 of Provincial Policy 409 calls for the Minister to approve a school closure or capital investment based on a recommendation from the DEC, we understand that such approval is not required with a vote of status quo. As such, I simply write to you now to inform you of the decision and bring a full sense of completion to the study.
