Good Evening,

At tonight's Public DEC meeting, the Council worked through a process regarding sustainability studies. As you are aware, a number of schools were "triggered" for study. The Council, however, can make the request to have certain triggered schools exempt from study for a period of 1 to 4 years. The Minister has to concur with the recommendations of exemptions...it needs to be a mutual agreement.

The final conclusion, at this time, is to launch two sustainability studies. These studies will be:

- 1) A study of Millville Elementary School and the three Nackawic Schools
- 2) A study of McAdam Elementary School

I share this news with you tonight so that you may not get caught off guard when it is shared publically. Naturally, we will talk more about what will occur in the next week or so.

Hi David,

Are the reps running in the rain today??? Jay said it was a good kick off yesterday. Our rep here, Anne Wilson, has had cancer touch her family and she is really honored to be doing this. So glad you spearheaded this.

As you know our PSSCs subgroup met last evening. Since I was taking notes they asked that I pass on to you the questions they would like answered before the meeting on Sept.29. Some are specific to the report that you gave us on NMS and others are general questions that they would like clarified about the process. Here goes...

1. Will there be a question time at the end of the DEC meeting on Sept.29?

Yes, there will be time for questions. Public Meeting #1 is all about sharing of information. It doesn't take the theme of swaying people in one direction or another regarding closure or status quo...it is more about ensuring everyone knows the facts about the schools being studied.

2. Does a DEC member have to attend all three meeting to vote?

There is not an attendance requirement regarding a DEC members right to vote. I have noted, however, that they take their responsibility very seriously and go through great strides to ensure they are well informed in leading up to the vote.

3. Enrollment states Trends from 1999 to Present. They would like our enrollment at NMS of 150 and 9 classrooms reflected as well as the corrections made to the initial cover page. *I let them know that the first page was draft and would have corrections made.* Also, the other schools would like to have the numbers reflected as 2015(present)

Enrolment will be presented as official September 30 numbers. This years enrolment will also be noted, although not considered official at this point.

4. Who was responsible for the list of Capital Improvement project items and they would like each of these itemized within the 630,000 for NMS. Cost breakdown before the meeting.

Our facilities team manages the list of capital improvement projects that are in our database. We don't include individualized estimates as it may get to a point where these projects are approved for funding and by listing the estimate, it would have an influence on the tendering process. I have cc'ed Shawn for his confirmation of what I have just said.

5. Is this cost projection to be done over the next 5 or 10 years? Timeline

Over a long period of time, possibly 5 or 10 depending on how priorities line up in the entire district. Each year, our list of projects (450 or so for the whole district) is prioritized, knowing that usually <30 get approved for funding an annual basis, depending on provincial budgets available

6 How does this compare to other capital improvement projects from other schools studied. They would like to see some comparisons.

What schools would they like to see? We can provide.

7. Specific questions about the Capital Improvement projects sheet from the report for NMS- Roof has already been done, 2004 and 2012 so this should be removed, exterior doors that were retrofitted for all the schools in ASD-w or WEC did not include NMS. This should have been a cost absorbed like all the others, driveway already repaired and paving done, three floors already replaced and no need for any others in the next 10, first page dealing with the mechanical/electrical system is inconsistent with the capital improvement page. Brick repointing???

Shawn will need to comment on this...

The subgroup is growing to include the mill H/R CEO, lawyer, ministers, etc. It has been good so far and we are keeping the meetings positive. It was mentioned last night that people are open to a new K-12 but will seek legal counsel should there be a recommendation to cram two schools into one..

Thanks for offering to come up to meet with the PSSC. The NMS PSSC group will be formed/added to on Sept.15 and first meeting is Sept.23. Not sure if we can squeeze in another meeting for you to explain the process as our chair is a really busy pharmacist along with the rest of the group being timepressed businessmen/women. I will certainly let them know of your offer for sure.

I think I have everything on my list of questions that they would like to know. And I apologize as I know you are busy but it will be more positive for the town and the school community if we have clarity about specifics as well as the process.

Morning David,

Our PSSC met last night as well as our "sustainability" group. They would like to thank you for your prompt answers to the questions they had from our last meeting:

They would like the updated copy of the NMS report before Monday. Your team will prob have this done this week since Phillip and Dwight came to update the Capital Improvement project list, I told them. This list seems to be something that they would like to be very accurate. The roof has been completely done at a cost of 242,543 so this will come off of the 630,000 as well as this summer's driveway/paving repair.(not sure of this cost). They discussed the window replacement capital improvement and noted that there were many windows already replaced in 98 so this should be modified as well. This seems to be the page the PSSC chairs are looking to have well calculated and are comparing to the other schools since one PSSC chair has children in all three schools. Also, the amendment to the opening page was looked at again along with your responses to their questions. They would like to see the school enrollment trends to present- include the increase of our pop this year as well as the increase to 9 classrooms which, changes the functional capacity.

Impact on Other Schools

Beyond a decision of status quo or a recommendation to fix/upgrade the schools as they stand now, the following scenarios rise to the surface as possible considerations:

- Creation of K-8 school within Nackawic Middle School as the site (with or without Millville Elementary School students pending outcome of sustainability study).
- Creation of a 6-12 school within Nackawic High School as the site.

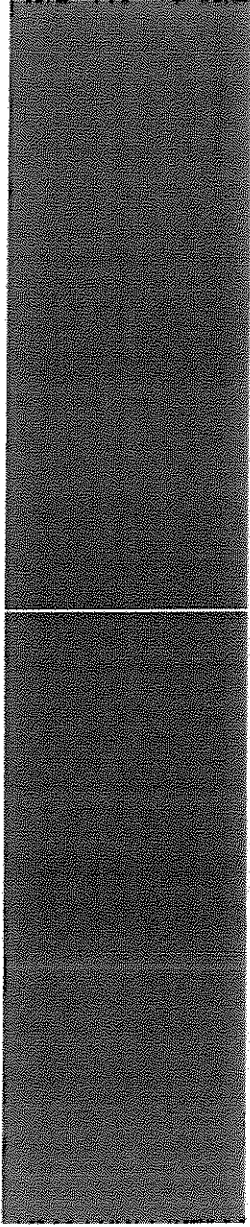
There does not appear to be capacity for a K-12 school in Nackawic with the current buildings. The construction of a new K-12 school serving 600-650 students would require government approval of a major capital construction project should it be recommended by the District Education Council.

It does not seem reasonable to consider moves to Fredericton, Harvey or Woodstock.

Hi Larry,

Here are the factors used for getting the capacity of the school depending on the grade configuration. So for an elementary K-5 it is the number of classrooms multiplied by 24 but when talking about a K – 8 it is the number of classrooms multiplied by 26.

Classroom Capacity – for the ease of calculation these factors are used for consideration of the maximum capacity within the classrooms in the various school grade configurations:

Grade Configuration	Factor	Grade Configuration	Factor
K – 2	21	3 – 5	28
K – 5	24	6 – 8	29
K – 8	26	6 – 12	29
K – 12	26	9 – 12	29

For functional capacity, we use what is called a capacity factor to determine the number and it changed from school configuration to school configuration. A K-5 is different from a K-8 which is different from a K-12 and 6-12 and 9-12. Jeanette Garland responded to my inquiry with the following response:

Someone is looking for enrolment prior to 1997 and I was going to ask him the following.. I believe he stated at the first meeting that NMS can hold 492 students but when I calculate to find a new K-8 functional capacity and take into account that there is only 17 classrooms the math does not seem to make sense as I believe the # of students should be based on classrooms and max student amounts.. Which does not mathematically work out when you are considering the maximums of primary grade and their maximums....unless that is not how it works then it seems like two different mathematical formulas are needed and would conflict each other.

Thank you for the information you provided last night, however I have a couple of comments in regards to last night's meeting.

The Middle School did a parent survey that has indicated that 92% wished to keep the school structure in Nackawic as status quo. This survey was sent in the spring so included the Grade 6-8 as well as sent to the current Grade 5 students. Should this information not be considered when discussing the possible closure of one of our local schools?

Also, the Town Office is being housed in the downstairs of the Middle School with a revenue for the district of \$14,400 per year. The community connection and impact of any disruption to the middle school structure would impact this agreement negatively. In a town where we have lost both our Town Office and Fire Hall due to a fire, it would be unfortunate to lose yet another Town Office location.
