

2019 SVHS Graduation Class Newsletter - June 5, 2019

Below is a list of fees associated with graduation and graduation activities to help you and your graduate plan:

Graduation Ceremony Fees are \$50 and are due now, but can be paid up until the day of pick-up for cap, gown, and invitations. (Gowns, caps, etc, have been ordered. We can only offer a small partial refund if you do not graduate as things are bought in advance. This fee covers the following expenses: gown rental, graduation cap & year date pendant (yours to keep), diploma, diploma cover, invitations, corsages, decorations and flowers for the ceremony. **Please note that all Delinquent Items must be paid or returned before students can pick up graduation gowns and invitations.**

Graduation Events & Activities:

June 15th - Prom in the Southern Victoria High School cafeteria will commence with the graduates arriving outside the SV Garden for the Grand Entrance at 7:30 pm. The Prom fee is \$40 and the theme is Rose Gold. The presentation of couples will occur outside as they arrive. They will be announced as they disembark from their vehicle before they enter the SV Garden to the school where the prom will be held.

June 17th - Graduation Banquet Supper will be at the Southern Victoria High School Cafeteria and will be catered by Kenda DeMerchant. **Students need to be there by 4:15 pm.** This event is limited to graduates, teachers and guest speakers. **We have set the serving time as 4:30 p.m..** Any special presentations will happen after the meal and/or between the main course and dessert. The price is \$15 per person. Graduates will be staying overnight at SVHS for Safe Grad. **This fee is due June 7th, 2019.**

June 17th - Safe Grad is at SVHS. Students who aren't participating in safe grad will leave the school after the banquet. All other students will remain at the school after the banquet for Safe Grad. The event will start right after Banquet and last until 5:30 am the following morning. Students must be picked up by a parent/guardian. No students are allowed to drive themselves from this event as they will be awake all night. The event will consist of the following activities: Mr. Kazakos' Leadership (two hours to start off the evening), Softball, Capture the Glow Stick, Hide and Seek, Bingo, Surprise Event, Breakfast, Movie etc. The cost per graduate for Safe Grad is \$40.00. This fee is due June 7th, 2019.

June 18th - Gown Pick-up 2:30 pm to 5:00 pm. Gowns and invitations may be picked up on June 18th from 2:30 pm - 5:00 pm at the Southern Victoria High School Library. Each graduate will receive 5 invitations. **All fees and delinquent items must be paid before cap and gown and invitations are given to graduates.**

June 19th - Homecoming Graduation Walk at Mahsos is at 9:30 am at Mahsos School. All First Nations graduates need to be there by 9:15 am.. All First Nations graduates will meet in the lobby of Mahsos School dressed in your cap and gown.

June 19th - Graduation Memory Walk at AES is at 1:45 pm at Andover Elementary School. All students are asked to meet in the cafeteria of SVHS at 1:30 pm dressed in your cap and gown and we will walk over together. Following the walk will be the graduation rehearsal at the RVCC. It is important that all grads show up to the event because the students of AES look forward to seeing you all in your cap and gown.

June 19th - Graduation Rehearsal starts right after the Memory Walk at AES. It is important that all grads attend the rehearsal and show up on time for the lineup. This is where you learn where you are in line for entrance, sitting on stage and your place in the recessional.

June 20th - Graduation Ceremony is at 4:00 pm at the River Valley Civic Center. Graduates need to meet in the main lobby of the school no later than 3:30 pm, with their cap and gown items. Flowers will be placed on your gowns. Late arrivals are NEVER allowed on stage. Male students need to wear long pants under their gowns; shorts will not be permitted.
