

Peter Kohler Scholarship

The Peter Kohler Scholarship is intended for students who demonstrate financial need, and is meant to provide an opportunity for young and bright students who might not be able to enroll in university if it were not for this funding. The scholarship(s) is **valued at \$50,000**, and is distributed over a period of four years - provided the student maintains a satisfactory grade point average and maintains a full time status.

Eligibility

To be eligible for this award, applicants must be from the Maritime Provinces, graduating from high school in June 2020, and entering their first year of full-time studies in an Engineering Program at a University in Atlantic Canada in Sept 2020.

Applicants will be adjudicated upon the basis of their academic standing, financial need and extra-curricular involvement.

Required Information

- An explanation of why you are requesting financial support (500 words or less). Provide an estimate of average household income including both parents, if applicable.
- An explanation of why you chose Engineering as your field of study (500 words or less).
- Your most recent academic transcript, in PDF format.
- Two letters of reference from a teacher, employer or community member who has known you for at least two years.
