There will be no school for students on Thursday, April 14th due to morning Parent/Teacher from 8:30 – 11:00 am and staff professional learning in the afternoon.

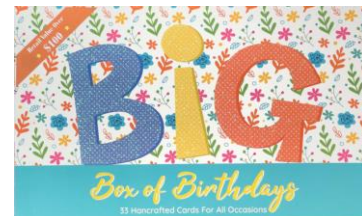
There is a section for families and students to write reflections on the report card. We encourage families to take the time to assist children in reflection and goal setting. There will be guiding questions in this section to provide an
