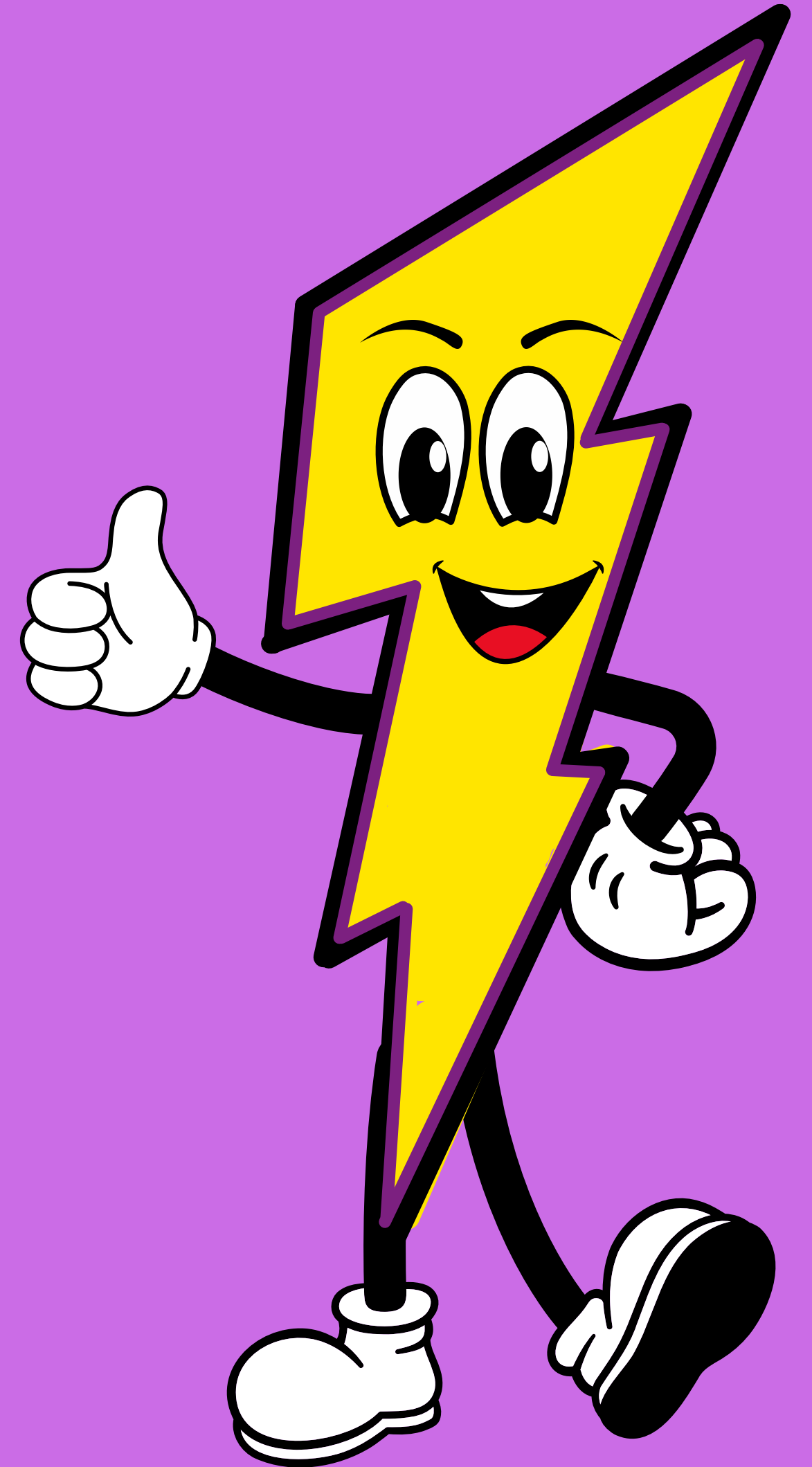

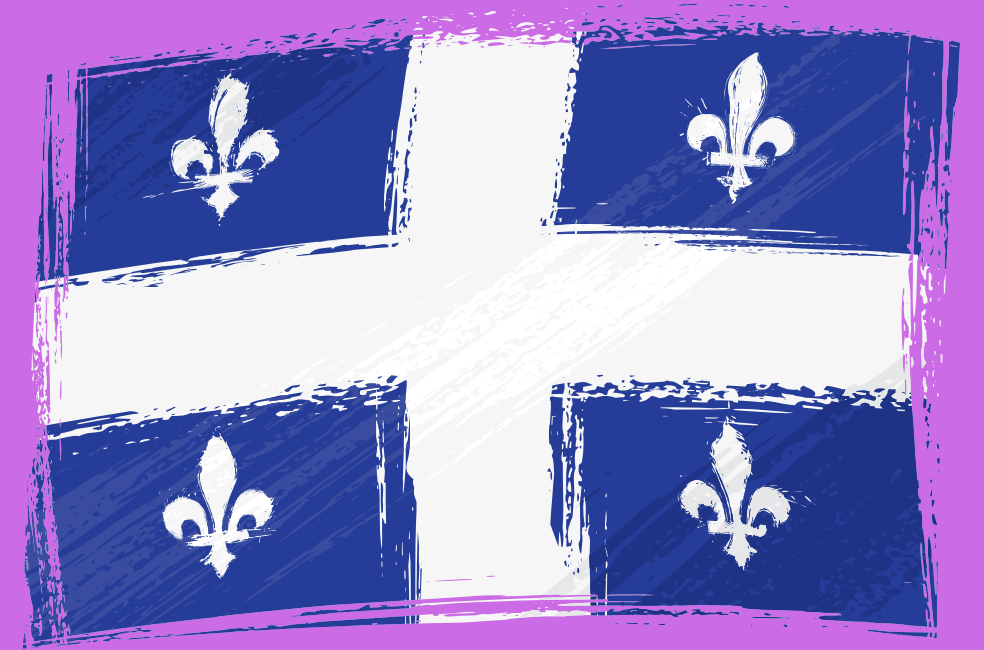
Easter Weekend

This is to show how diverse the Barnhill Community is and share each others cultures.

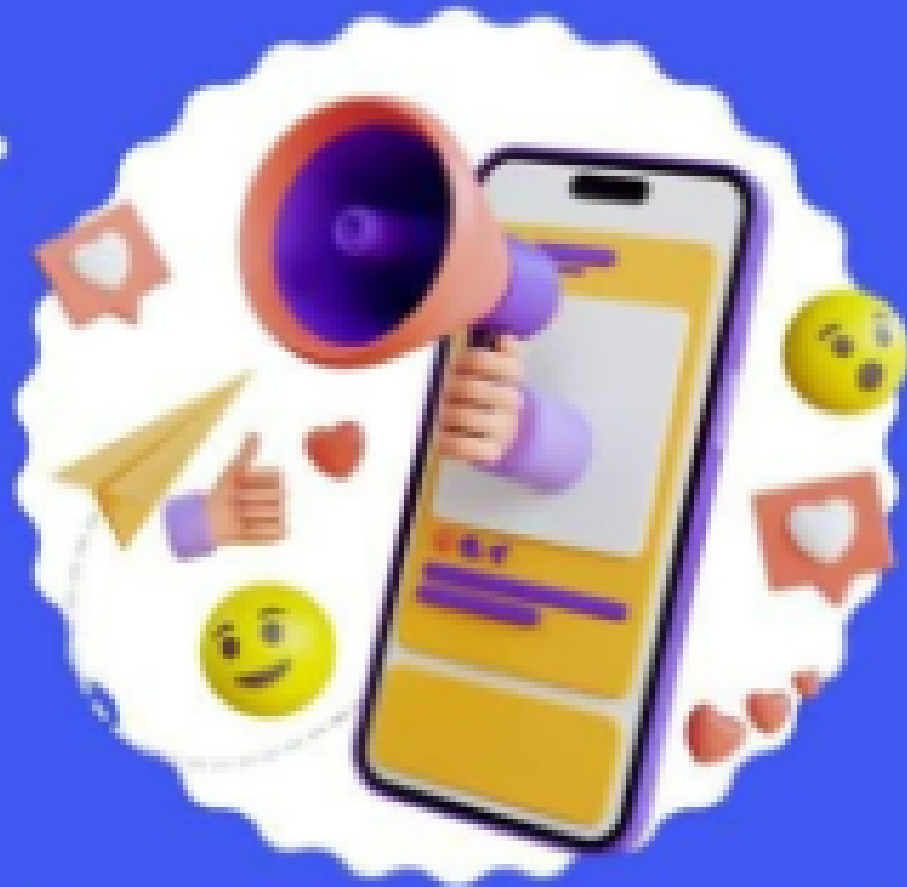
It will take place on Thursday, April 17th, from 5 - 7pm in the gymnasium.

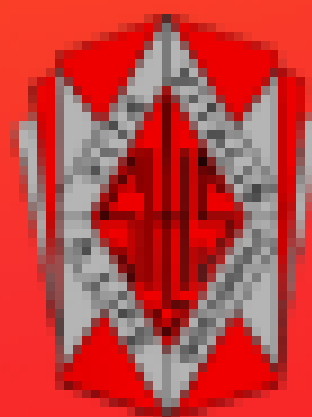

- We will compare the student's results from their vote to the actual Federal election results on Tuesday April 29

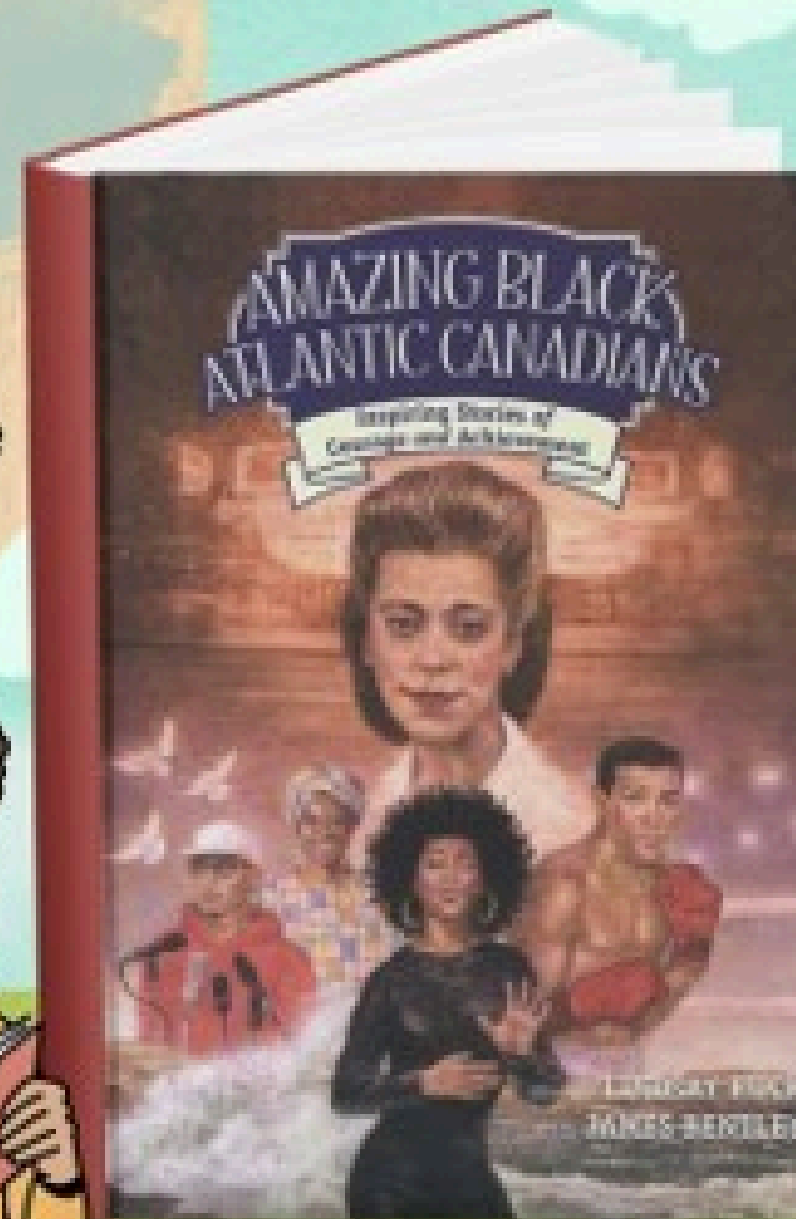


Join NBBHS for an engaging and educational event celebrating Black history and literature, featuring renowned Canadian author:
