Message to Parents/Guardians re Human Papilloma Virus Vaccination Clinic During School Closure, June 2020

Immunization is a very important public health measure in maintaining the health and wellness of a population.

The grade 7 Human Papilloma Virus (HPV) immunization clinic has been scheduled for:

DATE: June **16 and June 17**

CLINIC LOCATION: Bayside Middle School-Cafeteria

(these clinics were originally scheduled to take place at the school in the Spring)

All grade 7 students who have returned <u>a signed consent form</u>, in the fall <u>of 2019</u>, and have received the first HPV vaccination, will be offered the second HPV vaccination, to complete the series.

We will be adhering to strict social distancing guidelines during the immunization clinic and we ask that students:

- arrive at the school within their designated time frame (see table below)
- wear a <u>mask or scarf</u>, covering their mouth and nose
- enter the school alone
 - o The process will take ~30 minutes so parents are welcome to wait in their vehicle or leave the school property and return to pick up their child within the ½ hour time frame
 - If your child requires an aide or assistance, you are welcome to accompany him/her to the clinic however, you must also adhere to social distancing guidelines
- practice hand hygiene and cough/ sneeze etiquette
- wear a short sleeve shirt to ensure easy access to the arm

Staff will meet students at the entrance of the school and ensure the 2-meter (6 foot) physical distancing. They will have hand sanitizer, to provide to the students, as well as masks for those who do not have adequate mouth and nose coverage.

On the day of the clinic, if your child has any of the symptoms outlined on the **gnb.ca coronavirus site**, **please call 811** and do not go to the school. An appointment to receive the second HPV vaccination can be scheduled at your local Public Health office by calling **658-2454**, once your child is feeling better.

Every effort should be made to attend DURING your designated time slot. (As we are adhering to strict social distancing guidelines).
