The New Brunswick Teen Apprentice Program (NBTAP) is accepting applications from New Brunswick grade 10 students until March 31.

NBTAP gives students an opportunity to start a skilled trades pre-apprenticeship in Grade 10. During three paid summer work terms, Student Apprentices are mentored and coached by skilled trades employers, learning important workplace skills, and earning credits toward a skilled trade apprenticeship. NBTAP is currently recruiting grade 10 students for more than 50 new work placements in as many as 24 skilled trades, with employers throughout New Brunswick.

Available work placements vary depending on needs identified by local skilled trades employers.

The NBTAP selection process is competitive and each student must provide a suitable reference together with an application signed by both the student and parent/guardian. Student interest, capability for success in a skilled trade, and school marks and attendance records are also considered. The ultimate hiring decision is made by each employer following a short interview with eligible students.
