Guidance Corner

The Department of Education and Early Childhood Development (EECD) is offering a free online summer learning program for New Brunswick high school students entering grades 10, 11, or 12 in the upcoming school year and to those who graduate in June 2023.

This program allows students to earn a mark that will be added to their regular school transcript. These are full courses and take a significant amount of time to complete (~4 hours each day).

If students want to improve a mark or get ahead in a course, and they have the time to commit, this might be the right program.
