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Guidance Corner

On November 14th, our school will be participating in the annual provincial Student Wellness and Education Survey. This survey is a collaborative initiative of the Department of Education and Early Childhood Development, Department of Health, and the New Brunswick Health Council (NBHC). At the high school level, we are asked to advise parents that there will be questions about drugs, alcohol, and cannabis included in the survey.

Hire Potential supports students with intellectual or developmental disabilities. They can help with preparing for employment, developing skills, and planning for post-secondary. They can also develop resumes, cover letters, and help students find the right job. They work one-on-one with clients to develop an Employment Action Plan and support them to meet their goals. The time after high school can feel uncertain, and it is always helpful to have someone there to guide you.
